Software Activation

By far the most frequently asked questions we receive are "how to activate our software on a network?" and "why is my activation code invalid?".

Once activated, the software will not expire unless it is re-installed on a different machine or folder. However, the activation code you received at the time of purchase is machine specific and designed to expire. If you are required to re-install the software on another folder, machine, or network in the future, you may obtain a new activation code in seconds via our online registration feature located under the main "Administration" menu of the software. All that is required is a valid e-mail address and your unique serial number. This process takes only a few seconds and is available 24/7.

We are constantly trying to improve our setup, registration, and licensing procedures. In the end, our ultimate goal is to make this process invisible to our registered users but very annoying to pirates and those who compete for your clients on an uneven playing field.
